

# ***CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT***



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## **Full Road Closures on G Street and Kern Street in Fresno Alternative Routes Advised**

**FRESNO, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with the design-build contractor, Tutor-Perini/Zachary/Parsons (TPZP), announce full road closures in Fresno starting September 2. Detours will be in effect during the closures and motorists may experience delays. Pedestrian access will also be restricted and signage will be in place to redirect traffic.

**CLOSURES:**           G Street between Kern and Tulare Streets  
The full closure will begin on the morning of Tuesday, September 2 and remain closed until Friday, October, 10, 2014.

                              Kern Street between G and H Streets  
The full closure will begin on the morning of Monday, September 8 and remain closed until Friday, September, 12, 2014.

This schedule is subject to change.

Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to drive carefully and be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas. The Authority appreciates the patience and cooperation from visitors, residents and businesses during this work.

Road closures are in place as part of abatement and demolition activities associated with Del Monte Building. This work supports the ongoing pre-construction activities that are part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 29-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 17 in Madera County to East American Avenue in Fresno County.

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
