STATE ROUTE 99 CLINTON AVENUE ON-RAMP OPENS NEXT WEEK

FRESNO, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) are pleased to announce the northbound State Route 99 Clinton Avenue on-ramp will open to the public on Monday, August 20.

At this time, the northbound State Route 99 Golden State Boulevard on-ramp will close for approximately two months. A detour will be set up to help motorists traveling on McKinley Avenue and Golden State Boulevard access northbound SR-99 from Clinton Avenue via West Avenue (see detour map on Page 2).

The Clinton Avenue overpass was demolished last spring and rebuilt as part of the State Route 99 Realignment Project for the high-speed rail program. The new overpass, which opened back in November, was constructed to meet the horizontal and vertical clearance requirements of the high-speed train. The northbound Clinton avenue off-ramp also opened November 2017 and subsequent ramps opened in the spring.

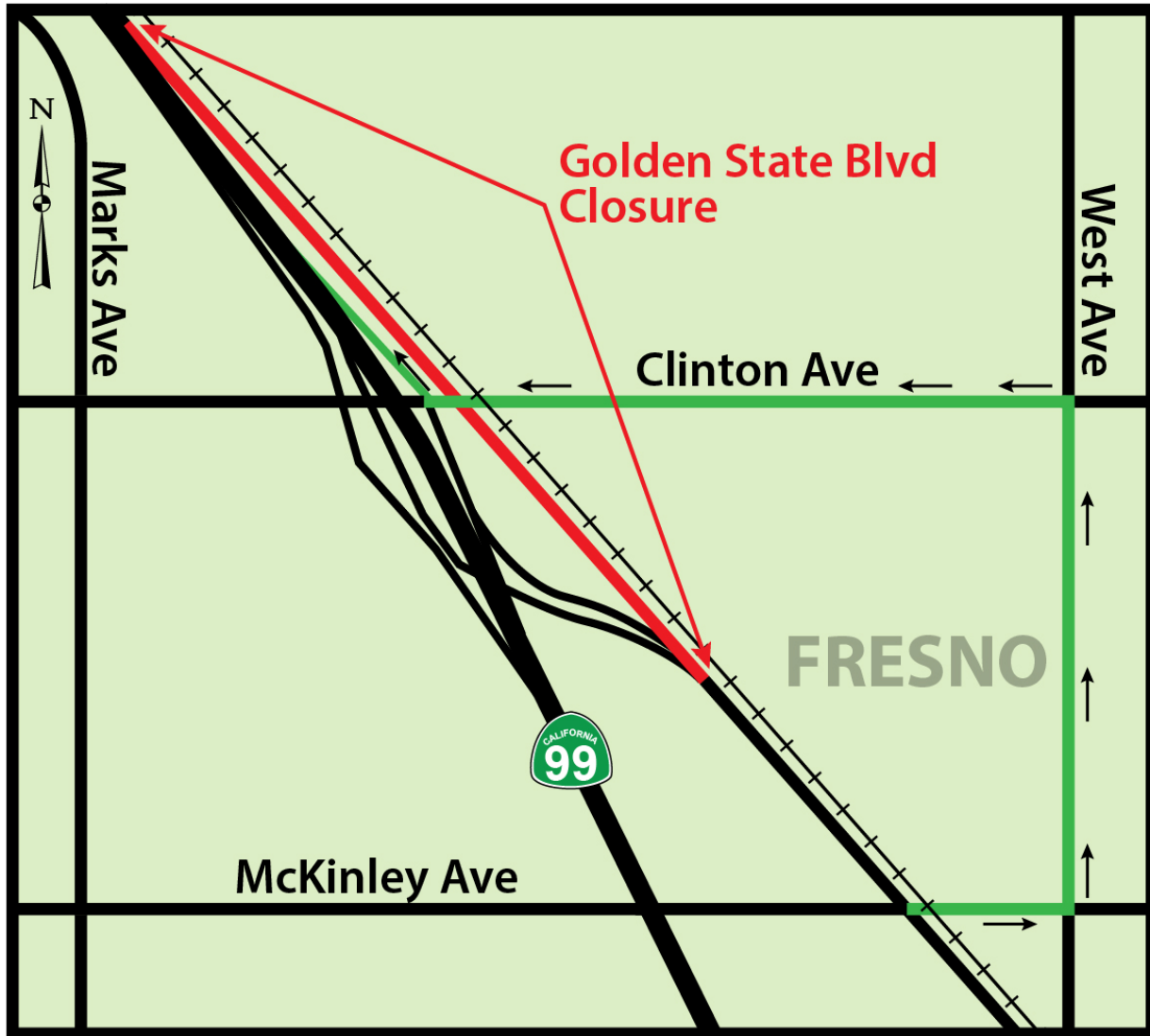
