## LANE CLOSURES & SHOULDER WORK IN THE CITY OF SAN JOSE

ISSUED: JANUARY 26, 2018

**SAN JOSE, CALIF.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with geotechnical consultant, Kleinfelder Inc., announces lane closures in the City of San Jose for field work associated with geotechnical explorations within the Silicon Valley to Central Valley line starting Monday, January 29. Work will occur between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m through February 2. No detours will be needed.

This work is being done to understand geologic and hydrogeologic conditions near and around locations in close proximity to proposed alignment alternatives under consideration. This work supports future engineering, environmental and procurements. Kleinfelder Inc. and Fugro Consultants will be performing drilling activities using a mud-rotary and CPT rigs.

A final alignment alternative through this area has not yet been selected, and will be done so through a public environmental review process.

- Pomme Court Between Olive Hill Drive and Winepol Loop

#### Starting Feb 1

- Monterey Rd southbound Between Branham Lande and Chynoweth Ave

#### Starting Feb 2

- Monterey Rd southbound Between Blossom Hill Road and Norman Y. Mineta Highway

### MEDIAN WORK

#### Starting Jan 29

- Monterey Rd northbound and southbound between Rancho Drive and Capitol Expressway

#### Starting Jan 30

- Monterey Rd northbound Located in parking pullout for Coyote Creek Trail

#### Starting Jan 31

- Within vacant lot at northwest corner of Branham Lane and Monterey Road

#### Starting FEB 2

- Monterey Rd southbound at offramp to Blanchard Road
