



# CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT

## LANE CLOSURES ON H STREET AND PALM AVENUE IN FRESNO

ISSUED: FEBRUARY 3, 2017

**FRESNO, CALIF.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor, Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures on Palm Avenue and H Street in Fresno for utility relocation activities scheduled to start Tuesday, February 7, 2017.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County to East American Avenue in Fresno County.



### H Street- This closure will be in place weekdays from February 7 – March 24.

- The westbound lane on H Street will be closed to thru traffic between Divisadero Street and Belmont Avenue
- The left eastbound lane on H Street between Arroyo Avenue and Roosevelt Avenue will be closed to thru traffic
- The intersection of H Street and Arroyo Street will be closed to thru traffic.

### Palm Avenue- This closure will be in place weekdays from March 27 – April 14

- The left southbound lane will be closed on Palm Avenue between Franklin Avenue and H Street.



- **Traffic going westbound on H Street will be detoured east on Divisadero Street, then north on Broadway, then west on Belmont Avenue back onto H Street.**
- **Traffic going eastbound on H Street will be detoured east on Belmont, then south on Broadway, then west on Divisadero Street back onto H Street.**
- **Traffic going eastbound on Arroyo Avenue will be detoured to north on Ferger Avenue, west on Franklin Avenue, then south on Palm Avenue onto H Street.**

**Drivers are expected to follow road closure signage and may experience delays; pedestrian access will not be restricted.**

Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel.
