



CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT

LANE CLOSURES ON SHAW AVE BETWEEN BLYTHE AVE AND GOLDEN STATE BOULEVARD

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor, Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures on Shaw Avenue between Blythe Avenue and Golden State Boulevard for utility relocation. Work is scheduled daily from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. starting approximately Monday, March 19 through Friday, April 6.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.



Multiple lane closures in the eastbound and westbound lanes on Shaw Avenue between Blythe Avenue and Golden State Boulevard. Work is scheduled daily from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. starting Monday, March 19, through Friday, April 6.



Drivers are expected to follow lane closure signage and may experience delays. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

This schedule is subject to change. For up-to-date information please visit BuildHSR.com or the Caltrans Quickmap. Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to drive carefully and be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas.
