



CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURE ALERT

WESTBOUND LANE CLOSURE ON SHAW AVENUE
BETWEEN GOLDEN STATE BOULEVARD AND STATE
ROUTE 99.

FRESNO, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor, Tutor-Perini/Zachry/Parsons (TPZP), announces a westbound lane closure on Shaw Avenue between Golden State Boulevard and State Route 99 for repaving. Work is scheduled to start Thursday, April 19 and last approximately two days.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.



Westbound lane closure on Shaw Avenue between Golden State Boulevard and State Route 99 scheduled to start Thursday, April 19 and last approximately two days. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.



Drivers are expected to follow road closure signage and may experience delays. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

This schedule is subject to change. For up-to-date information please visit BuildHSR.com or the Caltrans Quickmap. Traffic laws will be fully enforced and commuters are expected to be aware of the surrounding activities, remain alert and watch for construction vehicles and personnel. The public is asked to be extra cautious while traveling through the construction areas.
