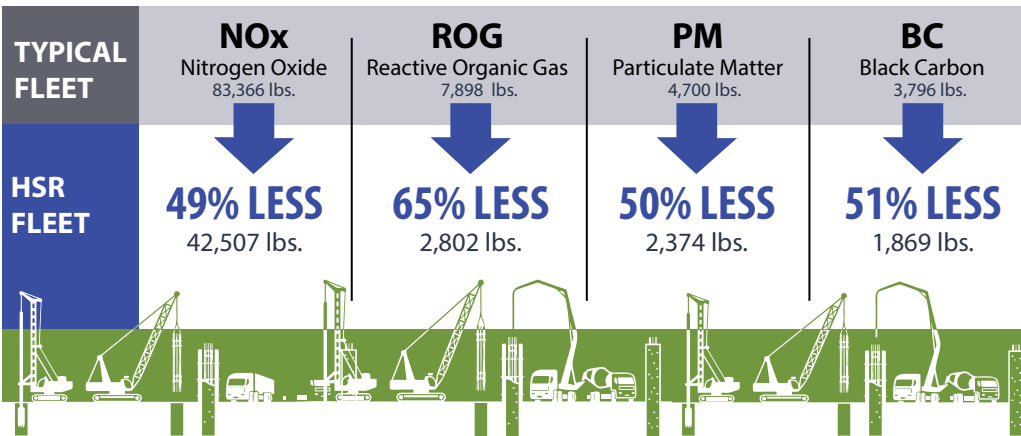

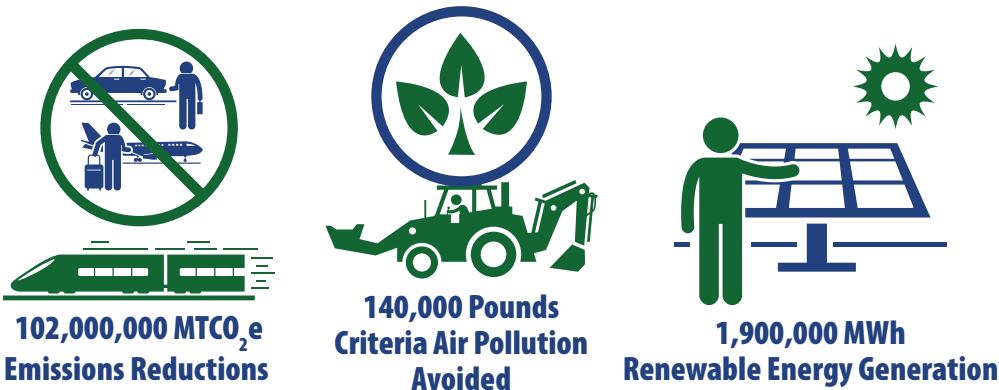
CUMULATIVE RECYCLING TO DATE
