California High-Speed Rail Authority Issues Progress Video and Improved Photo and Video Access

SACRAMENTO, Calif. – Today, the California High-Speed Rail Authority released the newest construction video highlighting the progress the Authority continues to make along the first 119-miles of high-speed rail infrastructure in Central Valley.
