

Los Angeles to Anaheim

Approximately 30 miles

Four Stations and/or Stops


- » Los Angeles Union Station (LAUS)
- » Norwalk/Santa Fe Springs Station
- » Fullerton Transportation Center
- » Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center (ARTIC)

4 Mainline tracks (2-electrified)

» Proposed infrastructure will accommodate HSR, Metrolink and other passenger rail volumes as envisioned in the 2018 State Rail Plan

Grade Separations


- » Improve operational characteristics for passenger and freight services
- » Improve safety
- » Reduce emissions and congestion
- » 11 new grade separations along the passenger rail corridor



Los Angeles to Anaheim Project Section

- BNSF owns the railroad right of way (ROW) between Los Angeles and Fullerton
- BNSF has historically allowed passenger rail service to operate on it's ROW through a shared use agreement
 - Provides for a maximum number of daily passenger trains to use the railroad ROW to accommodate shared passenger and freight train capacity
- To accommodate the growth in passenger rail service, including HSR, it will be necessary to relocate a portion of freight rail service away from the ROW and accommodate it elsewhere
- The relocated freight rail service is proposed to be accommodated at Lenwood and Colton



2014	PUBLIC SCOPING: Palmdale to Los Angeles Project Section split into two: 1) Palmdale to Burbank, and 2) Burbank to Los Angeles Project Sections
2014-2016	Alternatives Analysis for Palmdale to Burbank; Three alternatives presented to the public: SR14, E1 and E2
2018	"Refined SR14" presented to Authority Board as Staff-Preferred Alternative
2020	Three new alternatives SR14A, E1A and E2A added to avoid Una Lake and other community impacts; SR14A identified as Preferred Alternative
2022	DRAFT EIR/EIS: Six alternatives released for public comment


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SR14A Comparison to Other Alternatives

- Best constructability and lowest risk related to tunnels, hydrogeologic, and geologic conditions
- Shortest amount of tunneling within the Angeles National Forest (ANF) and the San Gabriel Mountain National Monument (SGMNM)
- Lowest impact on surface, groundwater and wildlife within the ANF because of least amount of surface hydrogeologic features
- Avoids impacts to Una Lake
- Avoids impacts to Pacific Crest Trail



Investing in Southern CA Southern California- \$1.3 Billion

Link US: \$441 million for Los Angeles Union Station (in federal environmental review process)

Safety Improvements: \$77 million for Rosecrans/Marquardt Grade Separation in Santa Fe Springs

Shared Corridor Improvements: \$363 million in environmental review work (for HSR, Metrolink, LOSSAN, others)

Connectivity Projects: \$389 million from Proposition 1A (Metro Regional Connector, Metrolink Tier 4, PTC)
