OBJECTIVE

Request for Action:

- » Release a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for high-speed trainsets to industry
- » RFQ will result in the receipt of Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from prospective trainset contractors
- » Authority will evaluate the SOQs and create a shortlist of qualified contractors capable of delivering high-speed trainsets
- » No funding is required for the RFQ process.




TRAINSET RFQ OVERVIEW OBJECTIVE

- Initiating the Trainset procurement process will allow Authority to:
 - » Meet our Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) / American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant timeline to start dynamic testing in December 2028
- Aligned with the 2023
 Project Update Report (PUR)



TRAINSET PROCUREMENT SCOPE OVERVIEW

- Procurement of 6
 trainsets capable of
 operating at 220 mph,
 tested to 242 mph
 - » Two prototypes to support static/dynamic testing and trial running
 - Delivery to Authority by 2028
 - » Four additional trainsets to support revenue operations of the Early Operating Segment (Merced to Bakersfield)
 - Revenue service by end of 2030



TRAINSET PROCUREMENT SCOPE OF WORK

In addition to the procurement of the trainsets, the Contractor will:

- Provide a driving simulator;
- Develop design criteria for facilities, track and systems contracts, and stations;
- Participate in the testing and commissioning of the facilities, track, and systems;
- Develop and provide information as required by law to support the certification and subsequent commissioning of the Trainsets;
- Maintain each Trainset for 30 years and provision of all Spares for such Trainsets; and
- Operate and maintain the Facilities (to be built by others).

TRAINSET PROCUREMENT TIMELINE

- Authority timeline from RFP to revenue service is projected to be 7 years
- Authority Trainset Procurement to span 1 year from RFQ to selection (pending notification of Federal Grant awards, or other funding in Q4 2023)
 - » Recommend the Authority progress the RFQ now to enable initiation of the RFP soon after Federal Grant awards, or other funding are identified

Procurement Goals

- » Prioritize the development of a validated model that simulates vehicle-to-track interaction with FRA acceptance
- » Co-locate team responsible for performing vehicle-to-track interaction testing



RELATIONSHIP OF TRAINSETS TO TRACK AND SYSTEMS

- Procurement of trainsets to be aligned with the Track and Systems procurement(s)
 - » Will allow the selected trainset contractor to identify critical interfaces to inform maintenance facilities, track and systems, and stations design
 - » Ensures that interface and integration requirements are complete, without conflicts



CHALLENGES & OPPORTUNITIES

Buy America & Tier III compliant

» Trainsets must meet new FRA Tier III regulations and Buy America requirements

Aggressive Schedule

» Operational availability to support Dynamic Testing By 2028

Evaluating opportunities for a joint procurement of trainsets

- » Benefits economy of scale
 - Increase base order of trainsets → drive competition
 - Spread non-recurring costs over a larger # of trainsets
- » Promotes interoperability

Seeking Board approval

- » Request for Qualification (RFQ)
 - Release of RFQ (August 25, 2023)

Future Board Actions

- » Approval of shortlisted firms and release of the Request for Proposal (RFP)
 - Release of RFP (Q1 2024) contingent on funding
- » Execution of Contract
 - Potential for Multiple Notices To Proceed (July 2024 = NTP 1)
