STUDENT JOB OPPORTUNITIES

There are opportunities for students to gain experience working on the California high-speed rail project. A number of student assistants, fellows and interns who worked on the project have gone on to full-time positions at the Authority.



Student Assistants

Student Assistants work in state departments to perform tasks within a variety of areas including information technology, engineering, human resources, communications and administration. For all positions, students must be actively enrolled in an accredited college or university in courses equaling 9 quarter or 6 semester units.
