## Notes

The Authority had one invoice amounting to \$46.50 that was paid late. However, the Authority was not required to pay penalties as the contractor was a State Agency.

The vendor disputes total is \$115.2M and consists of: Dragados/Flatiron Joint Venture \$112.4M, AECOM/Fluor Joint Venture \$756.1K, Wong + Harris Joint Venture \$694.9K, AT&T Corporation \$500.0K and other vendors \$849.0K.

There were 265 paid invoices totaling \$274.8M and 224 in-process invoices totaling \$49.4M during the reporting period.

The Authority has not made a penalty payment in over six years (83 months).

- (1) Administration/Support Costs of general operations of the California High-Speed Rail Authority.(2) onstruction/Right-of-Way Real property acquisitions and civil construction of the First Construction Section.
- (2) Rail Delivery Partner/Program Delivery Support An agreement for the integration, program delivery, and program management services of the California High-Speed Rail Authority.
- (3) Regional Consultants Agreements between Engineering firms and the Authority to ensure technical and contract requirements are met, services to include environmental clearance and preliminary design.
- (4) Resource Agencies These agreements provide support during the environmental review and approval process necessary to complete design and obtain a Record of Decision.
- (5) Third-Party Agreements These agreements are for the relocation, modification, reconstruction, and/or protection of utilities, irrigation facilities, roadways, and railways that are in physical conflict with the proposed High-Speed Rail System alignment.
