A TRANSFORMATIVE OPPORTUNITY: To Build the Nation's First High-Speed Rail System

The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) is responsible for planning, designing, building, and operating the first high-speed rail system in the nation. California high-speed rail will connect the megaregions of the state, contribute to economic development and a cleaner environment, create jobs, and preserve agricultural and protected lands.

When completed, Phase 1 of the high-speed rail system will run from San Francisco to the Los Angeles basin in under three hours at speeds of up to 220 miles per hour. The system will eventually extend to Sacramento and San Diego, totaling 800 miles with up to 24 stations. In addition, the Authority is working with regional partners to implement a statewide rail modernization plan that will invest billions of dollars in local and regional rail lines to meet the state's 21st century transportation needs.

In 2023, the Authority completed major milestones, including the following:

- Received awards totaling \$3.3 billion in federal funds to advance work on the initial operating segment between Merced and Bakersfield, a significant federal government reinvestment that renewed an important partnership;
- Advanced key procurements to evolve the system from construction to operations, including the procurements to purchase electrified trains, design the track and systems, and bolster engineering services in rail operations;
- The southernmost section of construction, Construction Package 4, covering 22.5 miles in the Central Valley reached substantial completion;
- Completed a record 17 structures in the calendar year and set records for the number of daily workers on job sites;
- Exceeded 12,200 construction jobs;
- Exceeded its goals for the percentage of right-of-way parcels acquired (98%) and the number of utilities relocated in a single year (250) along the current construction segment; and
- Met scheduled contract milestones for designs of the extensions to Merced and Bakersfield, as well as the four Central Valley stations.

The high-speed rail program will provide:

- Trips between San Francisco and Los Angeles in less than three hours;
- Train stations that are conveniently located in or near city centers for easy connections – arrive in cities, hop on a bus or a local light rail line, hail a taxi or a ridesharing service, rent a bike or walk to your final destination;
- Better access to more destinations without having to drive fast, easy connections between high-speed and regional/urban transit systems at existing hubs like the Salesforce Transit Center in San Francisco, Union Station in Los Angeles, and the ARTIC Station in Anaheim, as well as new high-speed rail stations in cities like Fresno and Palmdale;
- Safe, predictable trips arrive on time with no delays or canceled trips due to congestion, fog or bad weather;
- Less stress from driving long distances in heavy traffic arrive refreshed and ready to work or have fun;
- Work on your laptop, catch up on your reading or relax and enjoy the scenery; and
- Trains that are powered by 100% renewable energy a trip that is better for you and for the environment.


