RE:	California High-Speed Rail Authority Procurement Update

Summary

This informational item is to update the Board of Directors on the planned procurement schedule for various contracts to support the delivery of track and systems, stations, and the Merced and Bakersfield extensions.

Background

With the advancement of construction in the Central Valley, the Authority has initiated the next phase of the project and has begun planning the procurement of various contracts to support the delivery of track and systems, stations, and the Merced and Bakersfield extensions. Given the complexity of this new phase of the project, the Authority has taken a holistic approach in identifying all potential procurement methodologies that would be most suitable for the delivery of these contracts.

On May 7, 2024, the Authority hosted the HSR Small Business Fast-Track Networking Fair and Industry Update event, where this procurement schedule was presented to the industry. The focus of the event was to increase awareness of the Authority's upcoming procurements and small business opportunities.

Discussion

The Authority has held numerous internal cross-functional workshops focused on developing a comprehensive schedule that implements lessons learned and is reflective of the sequence in which these contracts need to be executed. This effort was critical to continuing to advance the Authority's commitment to delivering passenger rail service between 2030 and 2033. The outcome of the workshops was a revised contracting strategy. The revised strategy will result in more Authority design control, smaller contracts, and more collaborative contracting methods.

This informational item outlines the procurement schedules for various contracts that support the delivery of Track and Systems, Stations and Fresno Historic Depot, Merced, and Bakersfield Extensions.
