

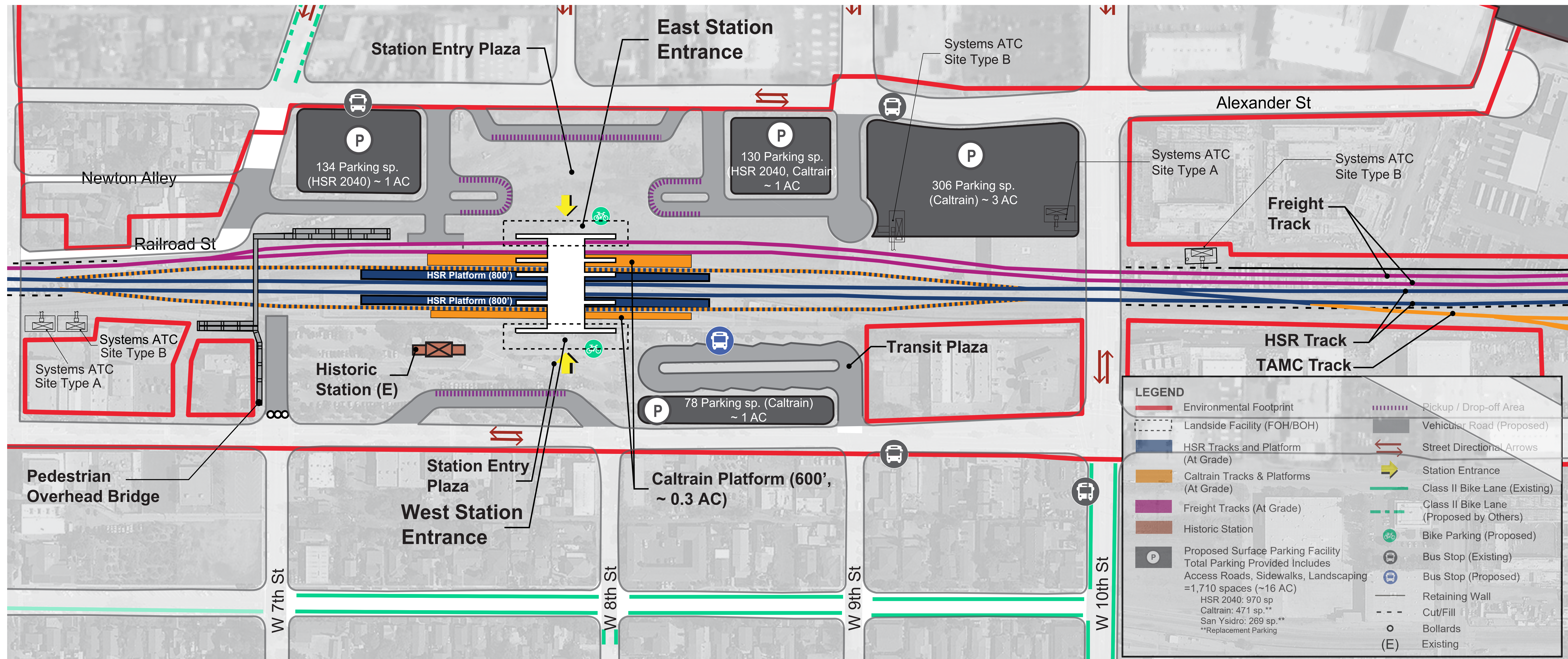


High-Speed Rail in Northern California

Gilroy station will be California High-Speed Rail's hub for Southern Santa Clara County. In addition to serving Caltrain and High-Speed Rail, it will offer connections to the Monterey Peninsula via planned new regional rail service to Monterey and Salinas.

Located adjacent to the existing historic rail station, the new station would be built along the rail line between Alexander Street and Monterey Road, extending from 7th and 10th Street. The Authority is working closely with the City of Gilroy on station-area planning and held several workshops in 2023 focused on transit and land-use goals for the area.

Gilroy Station Area Visioning Study

In partnership with the California High-Speed Rail Authority, City of Gilroy and the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), the Gilroy Station Area Visioning Study will establish a cohesive vision for the station area and Downtown Gilroy through community and stakeholder engagement.

The plan's goals are:

- Develop a long-term vision for the larger station area
- Create a desirable "sense of place" at the station that integrates into the surrounding community and Downtown Gilroy
- Set the stage for the subsequent more detailed Station Area Plan
