

Fresno Station Early Works Project Components

Staff seeks Board approval for a solicitation for construction bids for the Fresno Station Early Works Project, which consists of three subprojects:

- 1. Renovation of the Historic Depot
- 2. Early works and site improvements at the H Street Entrance (Downtown Plaza)
- 3. Early works and site improvements at the G Street Entrance (Chinatown Mobility Hub)






1. Renovate Historic Depot






2. Early Works and Site Improvements H Street (Downtown) entrance plaza

Project Funding Details

RAISE 2023 The Fresno Historic Depot Renovation and Plaza Activation Project will renovate, modernize, and preserve the historic Fresno Depot and will provide a plaza, electric vehicle charging infrastructure and space for transit charging in anticipation of the future California high-speed rail multimodal station.

Federal funds: \$19,400,000

(60.24%)

State funds: \$12,800,000

(39.76%)

Subtotal Project Cost: \$32,200,000

Federal State Partnership (FSP) Task 6: Fresno Station, Subtask 6.2 Construction Station Early Works includes, site demolition, utility relocations and connections, ground improvement, and landscaping.

Federal funds: \$20,720,000

(80%)

State funds: \$5,180,000

(20%)

Subtotal Project Cost: \$25,890,000

Total Project Cost: \$58,090,000

Basic Terms:

- Total contract value is up to \$58,090,000 (not to exceed).
- Total contract duration is 27 months.
- Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.
- Contract will be compliant with Small Business Requirements.

Next Steps

- Staff will complete PS&E package for contracting and solicitation
- Solicitation for bids is scheduled for third quarter 2025
- Contract Award and Notice to Proceed scheduled for December 2025
- Breaking ground on Fresno Station Early Works in 2026
