- The Authority has not made a penalty payment in over eight years (104 months) and did not have any aged invoices in the September 2025 reporting period.
- The Authority currently has a total of \$105.1M in disputed invoices, which represents a \$192.8 decrease in total disputes from the prior month. One contract accounts for 96.7% of the dispute total.

- The estimated Aug 2025 Cap-and-Trade auction proceeds are \$98.8M and will be reported once the transaction is completed by the State Controller's Office.
- The Proposition 1A cash balance decreased by \$101.1M, due to expenditures of \$109.4M and was offset by \$8.3M from the September Commercial Paper Sale.
- The Cap-and-Trade cash balance decreased by \$21.2M, due to expenditures of \$21.2M.
- The forecasted Revenues for the Rail Property Management Fund is \$2.7M for FY25-26, based on leases from 27 commercial, 16 residential, and 17 agricultural properties. The planned FY25-26 expenditures are \$2.6M for security, maintenance, utilities, taxes, and other Authority expenses related to managing the properties.

[•] At 25.0% of the Fiscal Year completed, \$19.9M or 19.2% of the Administrative Budget (\$117.5M) has been spent, resulting in a budget underutilization value of 5.8%. The budget underutilization is due to position vacancies and low OE&E spending.

- The Authority has filled a net total of 33 vacant position(s) over the past 12 months (from 356 to 389 filled positions).
- As of September 2025, the Authority's vacancy rate is 24.3% and the statewide vacancy rate is 17.0%.

[•] During the reporting month, the Authority completed recruitment for 11 vacant positions; however, the filled positions were offset by 12 separations, resulting in a net increase in vacant positions of one.

- Construction Package Monthly Expenditures totaled \$89.0M, which includes: CP1: \$41.9M, CP2-3: \$46.1M, and CP4: \$1.0M.
- Design-Build (DB) Monthly Expenditures totaled \$77.7M, which includes: CP1: \$36.3M, CP2-3: \$41.5M, and CP4: \$0.0.
- Monthly expenditures Time Impact Analysis (TIA) settlement payments totaling \$2.9M, which includes: CP1: \$2.9M, CP2-3: \$0.0, and CP4: \$0.0.

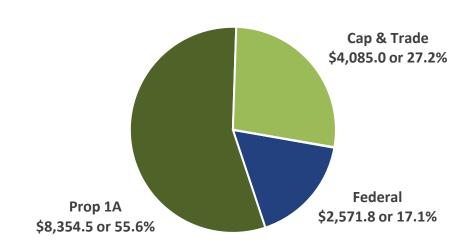

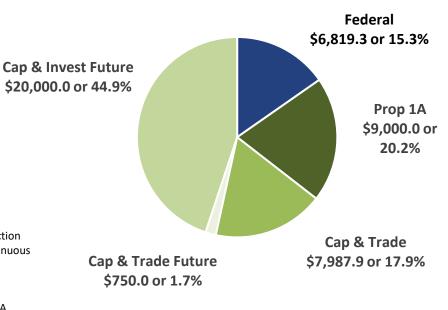

- Contracts are predominately issued for a variety of services, such as design-build and environmental work, while purchase orders are generally used to acquire goods.
- The Authority has 186 active contracts and 139 active purchase orders (PO's) with a total value of \$11.95B.
- Month-over-Month the value of active contracts increased by \$44.5M. The change in value of active contracts is primarily due to the removal of one expired contract for \$93.7M. This was offset by executed change orders for design-build contracts \$4.8M (CP1: \$3.1M, CP2-3: \$1.8M, CP4: \$0.0M; the addition of seven new contract(s) for \$27.3M, and amendment(s) of three contract(s) for \$106.1M).
