

10 EIR/EIS DISTRIBUTION

The distribution of the Los Angeles to Anaheim Project Section Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) emphasizes the use of electronic media to ensure cost-effective, broad availability to the public and interested parties. The Draft EIR/EIS (Volume 1), technical appendices (Volume 2), and alignment plans (Volume 3) are available on the California High-Speed Rail Authority's website (www.hsr.ca.gov). Electronic copies of the Draft EIR/EIS (all volumes) and supporting technical reports are available upon request to all members of the public by calling (877) 669-0494. Printed or electronic copies of the Draft EIR/EIS (all volumes) and electronic copies of the supporting technical reports are available for review at the office of the California High-Speed Rail Authority (770 L Street, Suite 620, Sacramento, CA 95814) and its Southern California Regional Office (355 S Grand Avenue, Suite 2050, Los Angeles, CA 90071). Printed or electronic copies of the Draft EIR/EIS can also be reviewed at the libraries listed in Section 10.1, Repository Locations.

All persons, agencies, and organizations listed in Sections 10.2, Federal Agencies, through 10.8, Schools and Districts, of this chapter have been informed of the availability of and locations to obtain the entire Draft EIR/EIS, as well as the timing of the formal comment period. Notice of availability of the entire Draft EIR/EIS has been published in the *Federal Register* in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act. Repositories and cooperating federal agencies were sent copies of the Draft EIR/EIS (all volumes) in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act and California Environmental Quality Act. Electronic copies also were filed with the California State Clearinghouse in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act and through the e-NEPA electronic filing system in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act. A copy of the Notice of Availability was displayed at the County Clerk offices for Los Angeles and Orange Counties, either in hardcopy or electronic format on their website.

A notification letter in English as well as a meeting notice and notice of availability in English, Spanish, and Korean, with other languages available on request, were mailed to owners and occupants of properties within 500 feet of the project alignment and 0.5 mile from proposed grade separations. In addition, a meeting notice in English, Spanish, and Korean was mailed to interested parties who indicated their interest in the project and had requested to be kept informed, along with emails. Materials in other languages were made available on request.

The Executive Summary also has been translated into the primary languages used throughout the Los Angeles to Anaheim area, specifically Spanish and Korean. In addition to the persons, agencies, and organizations listed in this chapter, additional local elected officials, agency representatives, and all others on the project mailing list have been mailed a notification that includes information on how to access the entire Draft EIR/EIS.
