The overpass, completed in June 2025, is in Tulare County and was one of several high-speed rail structures impacted by the heavy rains in 2023. The berms were also used by farmers to transport livestock out of the flooded areas. Now that it's all dried out, it plays host to giant pets.

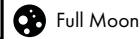


