



## High-Speed Rail in Northern California

# Stations | San Jose Diridon

On April 28, 2022, the Authority's Board of Directors certified the Final EIR/EIS and approved the Preferred Alternative for the San Jose to Merced Project Section, which includes modifications to the existing Diridon Station to accommodate high-speed rail service.

The approved alternative will result in relatively small changes to the station to allow for high-speed rail service. The historic train station would remain in place. Station updates would include (1) modification of two existing platforms to accommodate high-speed rail trains, (2) the addition of up to two pedestrian concourses to access the high-speed rail and Caltrain platforms, and (3) access improvements around the station

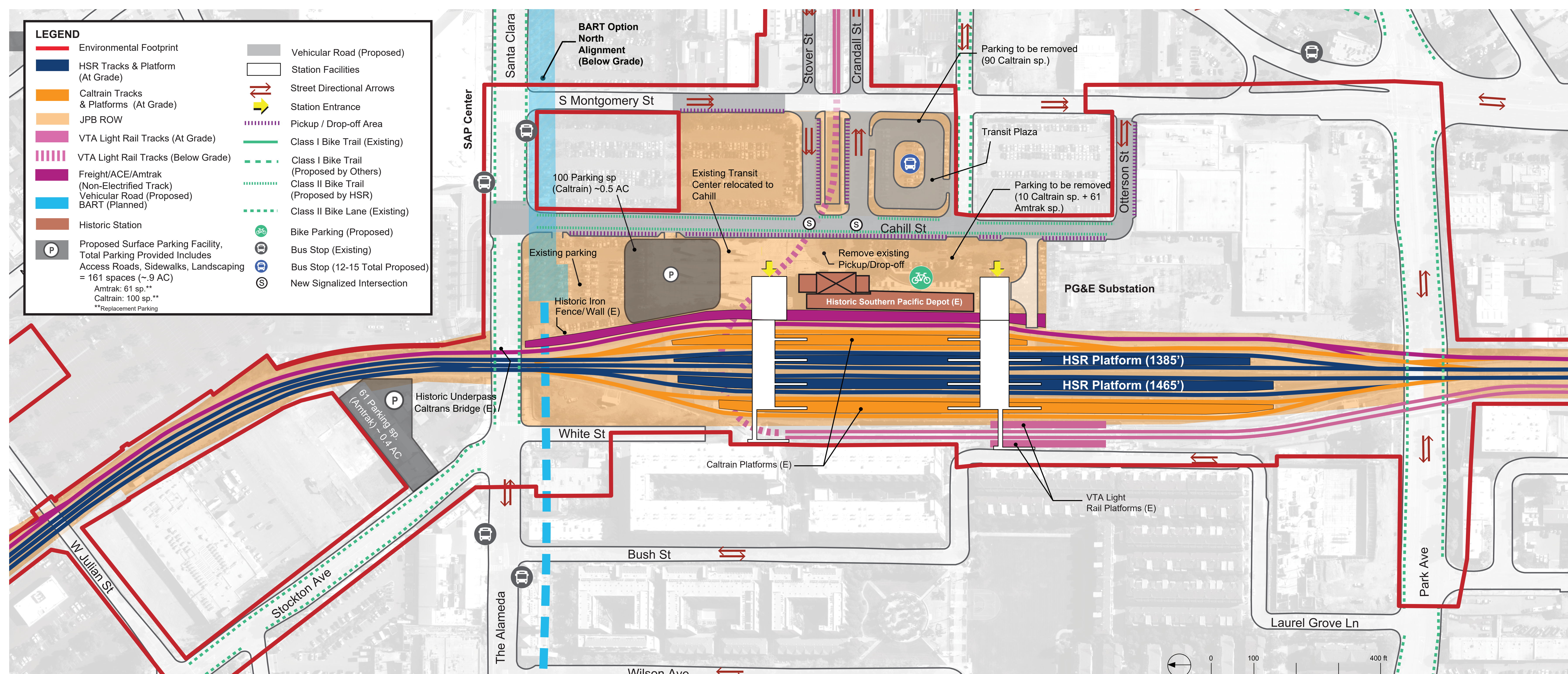
